

# Starting order



Startlist is created with a draw using FIS-list (list 3). 25% of the entry's are seeded in to two groups, A-group(50%) and B-group(50%) who starts B, A, B, A and so on.

Others are ranked using FIS-list and placed before the seeded group. The ones without FIS-points are placed at the beginning of startlist.







#### Jury decision

Members of the national teams, with FIS points negative affected by illness or injury last season and could be of interest for WC in Ruka should be within the seeded group according to ICR 314.6.1 for the competitions on Friday, Saturday and Sunday.

Only ski in the right direction both athletes and coaches

Please respect instructions from all officials

No one except competitors is allowed to be on skis on the course during the competition - Clear Course!

Note the rule of overtaking

Come to start in good time before - poles should be measured

SWE athletes, wear your transponders - check battery





# Measuring body- and pole length

310.2.1.4

The jury may ban the use of specific techniques on marked sections of the course. All infractions will be reported to the jury

Pole length rules, more information tomorrow







387	Sanctions, protests and appeals
387.1	In principle art. 352 applies. Any evidence on rules infraction, submitted within 48 hours after the last participant has finished the main race, must be considered and decided by competition jury within 72 hours after the first participant has finished the race.
387.2	Protests concerning skiers with active FIS codes can be filed within 1 hour after the first participant has finished the main race. Such a protest must be filed according to ICR 361.4 and 361.5.
387.3	Protests concerning other participants can file a protest within 48 hours after the first participant has finished the main race. Such a protest must be filed according to ICR 361.4.
387.4	Participants with no active FIS codes have no right to appeal.
